# THE COURSE

The Maine Orthopaedic Review is an 11-day course that starts with 5 days of lectures and 6 days of self- paced computerbased instruction, review and question bank.

#### ACCOMMODATIONS

Colby offers housing both in dorms on campus and in a new facility in downtown Waterville (The Commons), which is located approximately 2 miles from campus. For more information about the Commons, visit http://www.colby.edu/ residentiallife/alfond-commons/. Because they are college residence halls, all rooms have shared baths. There are double and single rooms. Light maid service of common areas, pillows, linen, blankets and towels are provided. Rooms are assigned on the basis of the date we receive a housing application. Therefore, early registration is suggested. If you have a disability, please advise us on your registration. Dorm rooms on campus are not air conditioned.

#### FEES

The fee includes lodging, all meals (dinner June 22 thru breakfast July 3), a jumbo lobster bake and use of campus amenities.

#### **Campus Dorms**

A single room for the duration of the course is \$1,000; Double room (shared with another registrant), is

\$900 per person. For less than 10 nights, the fee is \$100 per night. We do offer a weekly rate of \$500 (up to 6 nights).

#### Commons

For the Commons, the fee is 1,200 (single room in a shared suite) for the duration of the course or a weekly rate of 700 (June 22 – July 3) is available.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

Colby's campus is located two miles off Interstate 95 and is easily accessible by a number of modes of transportation. Several major airlines provide service to Portland (PWM) and Bangor (BGR) and Amtrak has train service to Portland and Brunswick. Bus service is available to Waterville and to Augusta about 20 minutes away. Waterville is 190 miles, about three hours north of Boston.
